Pattern:

Ribbed Brim:

- 1. Cast on 72 stitches.
- 2. Knit 1, purl 1 for 6 rounds.

Body of Hat:

- 1. Switch to stockinette stitch (knit every round).
- 2. Knit until the hat measures approximately 5 inches from the cast-on edge.

Crown Shaping:

- 1. **Round 1:** Knit 18, *knit 2 together, knit 1* around. (60 stitches)
- 2. Round 2: Knit every stitch.
- 3. Round 3: Knit 15, knit 2 together around. (48 stitches)
- 4. Round 4: Knit every stitch.
- 5. **Round 5:** *Knit 12, knit 2 together* around. (36 stitches)
- 6. Round 6: Knit every stitch.
- 7. **Round 7:** *Knit 9, knit 2 together* around. (24 stitches)
- 8. Round 8: Knit every stitch.
- 9. **Round 9:** *Knit 6, knit 2 together* around. (12 stitches)
- 10. Round 10: Knit every stitch.

Close Crown:

1. Pull the remaining stitches together and fasten off.

Finishing:

Weave in any loose ends.

- Gauge is essential: Take the time to check your gauge before starting the hat. This will ensure that your finished piece fits your doll perfectly.
- Don't overtighten your stitches: Keep your stitches loose enough to allow for a bit of stretch, especially in the ribbed brim.
- Use a stitch marker: Mark the beginning of each round to keep track of your progress.
