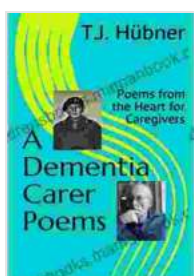


Poems From The Heart For Caregivers

The Gift of Caregiving

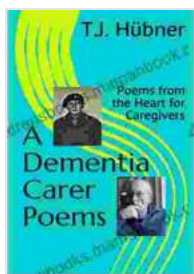
Caregiving is not always easy. There are days when it is hard to keep going. But there are also days when it is a gift.
