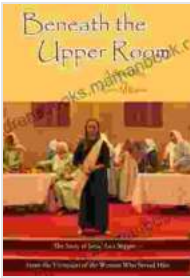

The women and the disciples eat and drink.

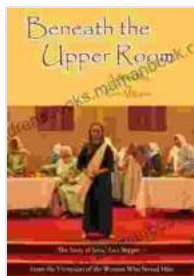
Woman 1: (to herself) This is a special moment. I will cherish it forever.
